## Young Person in Custody who is subject of a Pathway Plan but not Looked after Flowchart

Youth Offending Service (YOS) practitioner refers to Children's Services, Leaving Care Services and follows up in writing (using Child Protection/Child in Need Referral Form found at <a href="www.sunderlandscb.com">www.sunderlandscb.com</a>) on the day of sentencing, having informed the parent/carer. The referral should be copied to the Safeguarding and Quality Assurance Unit.

Open cases do not require an Initial Assessment.

Liaison with YOS to ensure streamlined reviewing to ensure there is no duplication of meetings

I.e.:

- DTO planning meetings and Pathway Plan review to be held at same time for consistent planning
- Ensure plans are complimentary and compatible

Leaving Care Worker (LCW) to provide Pathway Plan to Custodial establishment within 48 hours of custodial sentence being given. LCW to be present at DTO Planning meeting.

LCW to make any necessary amendments and to forward the plan to the Child and Custodial establishment following the initial meeting within 10 working days.
